



During our previous mobility to Portugal in November 2022, we decided to lay foundations for future collaborations between our schools, hosting some Portuguese teachers. Before the partecipants' arrival we exchanged ideas about the programme and shared a formal agreement on roles and responsibilities.

From 8 to 12 April, two teachers of the school group Father Benjamin Salgado, Portugal took part in a KA1 mobility at Valmorea secondary school, in the jobshadowing mode within the frame work of the ERASMUS+ programme.



They visited our school, met IC Valmorea principal, teachers and local authorities giving information on their own schools, cities and countries.





They attended different lessons (English, Italian, Geography, ICT, Science) as there was a group of IC Valmorea teachers (Prof. Roncoroni, Carlini, Gusmano, Cappelletti, Baggi) who felt they could show some experience and teaching methods.

We make them visit Valmorea, Molera caves, Setificio school and Como with its lake. In their free time they visited other places in our region and in the nearby Switzerland.









The participants' feedback is very positive and encouraging. It is nice to hear that our school is good and that it is possible to learn from us. It is also nice to see that all work done at school has good results and that we can share good examples of practice.

On the other side, the benefits for us are numerous. We had the opportunity to share knowledge and practices with our Portuguese colleagues and with French colleagues who were participating in another Erasmus project that our school was hosting at the same time. The atmosphere in school has become different, more colleagues have been involved, students have become open towards different cultures and languages, and the visit of European teachers has been a benefit for our entire community.
